

Urban Omnibus is seeking interns

The Urban Omnibus team is accepting applications for a fall/winter 2011 internship. Interns work closely with Omnibus staff in a collaborative work environment and perform a wide variety of tasks. Candidates should have an interest in design, architecture, and urbanism, and must have strong communication, organization, and writing skills.

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing material for online publication, including writing, layout, editing and fact checking
- Researching future features and events; staying on top of news feeds and incoming story ideas
- Assisting with administrative tasks such as the Omnibus weekly email and database updates
- Coordinating outreach and audience-building efforts

Opportunities will exist for the intern to develop his/her own feature in collaboration with editors. Experience in writing, editing, graphic design, mapping, or audio/video production is preferred.

Working for Urban Omnibus is a great opportunity to acquire wide-ranging experience in journalism, new media, audio/video production, architecture and urbanism as well as exposure to curatorial, editorial and non-profit management.

This is an unpaid internship, though we provide a travel stipend and are open to discussing independent study or credit opportunities. Interns are typically in the office two days per week. Hours are flexible, though regularity in schedule is preferred.
