

June 15, 2021, New York, NY—The Architectural League of New York is pleased to announce the opening of *Housekeeping*, an online exhibition featuring original work by the winners of the 2021 League Prize for Young Architects + Designers. The competition theme, *Housekeeping*, asked entrants to contemplate how stay-at-home orders have prompted many of us to see our domestic settings anew, and to consider the various ways in which we “keep house.” For the online exhibition, the winners have created installations including site-specific interventions, scale models, videos, composite streetscapes, and interactive platforms, which can be viewed onsite in their respective locations or in entirely digital formats.

Housekeeping moves from the virtual to the physical through a poster that, thanks to an engaged network of past and present League Prize winners, can be found on walls and windows of institutions and locations across North America.
