The award recognizes individuals and firms who are addressing pressing contemporary issues, from climate change and resource extraction to social inequities and exploitative labor practices, with a distinct "voice" that has the potential to influence the disciplines of architecture, landscape architecture, and urban design. The jury reviews firms that have a significant body of realized work and considers accomplishments within the design and academic communities as well as the public realm. The work of each Emerging Voice represents the best of its kind, and resourcefully employs architectural thinking to address contemporary concerns within the discipline and broader community.
