Every two years, the League recognizes eight practices whose work represents the best of its kind and resourcefully employs architectural thinking to address contemporary concerns within the discipline and broader community. Through an invited competition, the jury reviews individuals and firms that have a significant body of realized work and considers accomplishments within the design and academic communities, as well as advocacy and the public realm, with a focus on work that engages challenges from climate change and resource extraction to social inequities and exploitative labor practices. This year's winners

each present a distinct "voice" that has the potential to influence the disciplines of architecture, landscape architecture, and urbanism.
